ARRIVAL INFORMATION FOR SCHOOLS

Dear Teachers, Parents, and Students.

We are so excited to welcome you to Brisbane Powerhouse to see a show. To ensure a smooth visit, here are some tips:

GETTING HERE

If you have organised a coach bus or similar for your excursion to Brisbane Powerhouse, please advise your bus company to drop your group off inside the New Farm Park Ring Road, at the loading zone – shown in **blue** on the map below.

The loading zone is close to the venue entrance, and you can catch a glimpse of the roses and river on your way in!

Please note coaches and buses are <u>not permitted</u> on Lamington Street.

If you are driving by car, we have a paid carpark option off Lamington Street roundabout.

If you're catching public transport, a ferry or bus is the way to go! Remember to seek advice from the <u>Translink Journey Planner</u> before you leave.

LUNCH AND RECREATION

If you arrive early, which we encourage, take advantage of the ample shaded grassy areas in New Farm Park. This provides a perfect opportunity for your group to enjoy lunch before or after the show.

BACKPACKS AND SEATING

We encourage you to leave your backpacks on the bus, if possible. This helps everyone to keep the seating bank clear and allows you to move safely and freely during the show. We don't offer a cloaking / bag storage facility.

TOILET FACILITIES

Public toilets are conveniently located in the park near the drop-off zone, shown in **orange** on the map below. There are also toilets inside the venue.

We recommend arriving early to allow time for your students to use the facilities, as there will be other groups with similar needs.

ACCESSIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

HEADING INTO THE THEATRE

Doors for the show will usually open 30 minutes before the scheduled start time. Please check the door number on your ticket and arrive at your door no less than 15 minutes before the show start time.

Please have your tickets ready to show our ushers who will help you find your seats.

For large groups, please wait outside and notify us of your arrival. A staff member will then assist you to enter the theatre.

THEATRE ETIQUETTE

For the enjoyment of all and the safety of performers and patrons please adhere to the following rules:

- For the safety of performers and comfort of other patrons, the use of mobile phones, flash or phone torch, or filming or photography of any kind are not permitted during the performance. Sometimes there are exceptions, and we will advise of these on the day.
- For the respect of fellow patrons, students should not move in and out of allocated seats after the lights go down unless necessary. Trips to the toilet are necessary though!
- Food is not permitted in the theatre. Drinks are permitted but need to be in a plastic cup or bottle.
- To minimise interruptions to the performers and other patrons, latecomers may not be admitted
 into the theatre until a suitable break in the performance. The Front of House team will let you
 know when it's okay to go back in.
